The role of these committees is to organise any Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island events and to promote and maintain excellent teaching practises for the schools Aboriginal students.

Every term the two schools arrange a BBQ together for the Aboriginal community. The aim of these BBQ's is to swap information between staff and parents/carers in an informal setting. This year we have been meeting at the netball courts for a BBQ and friendly game of netball. The community development outcome from these meetings has been substantial.

Our next BBQ is scheduled for Thursday December 1<sup>st</sup> at 4pm. We would like to hold this terms event at the swimming pool and wish to enquire about any fee reduction that may be available through the council for this activity. We will promote this event and acknowledge and advertise this partnership with Council, if it eventuates.

We estimate there will be approximately 10 teachers, 10 parents and about 25 students. That is a total of 45 attendees.
