Elva Jones addressed the Council on improvements to street lighting and footpaths in Kyogle and asked Council to consider funding a new historical display proposed for the Kyogle pool.

Mrs Jones requested the Council investigate installing street lighting along the footpath from the railway viaduct to the entrance of the Kyogle Showground and possibly to the rugby league grounds. She told the Council she had had a fall while walking to a meeting of the Kyogle Showground Trust last week about 6.30pm. Mrs Jones said the fall was caused by a lack of adequate street lighting which had resulted in her being unable to see the footpath. She also pointed out that there was no street lighting along the footpath Council had built from Kyogle to the rugby league grounds at New Park, making the footpath almost unusable after dark.

Mrs Jones asked Council to consider building a footpath in Ettrick Street, Kyogle. She said there were a number of elderly people living in the area who could not walk on the undulating ground beside the road nor could they walk on the road because of the dangers posed by the loose gravel.

Mrs Jones also proposed a new display be mounted at the Kyogle pool in recognition of the voluntary work undertaken by Tom Dodds, a driving force behind community efforts to have the new Kyogle pool built, and Don Frith, a former Kyogle, Far North Coast and NSW representative swimming referee. She proposed the display include photographs of the two men as well as a NSW referee's blazer owned by Mr Frith. Mrs Jones is currently in possession of the blazer and suggested Council pay to have the blazer mounted.
