The new Daleys Bridge on Tabulam Road will be officially opened on Tuesday 12 September 2017 at 10am and Kyogle Council is inviting the community to attend.

The old one-lane timber bridge has been replaced with dual lane steel truss bridge.

The \$450,000 project was funded through the Federal Governments Roads to Recovery Program. The construction works took Council and its contractors 11 weeks to complete.

Tabulam Road was closed to through traffic while the bridge was being built. Kyogle Council used the road closure as an opportunity to also upgrade two sections of Tabulam Road -- 400m of road north of the bridge and 800m of road south of the bridge.

The road works were funded by Council for the southern end and by Mountain Blue Farms for the northern end.

Mayor of Kyogle Council Cr Danielle Mulholland will officially open the new bridge.
