

The completion of the \$1 million Lions Road Upgrade Project was celebrated yesterday (Tuesday, 30 March) with a small ceremony at the Lions Shelter.

Mayor Danielle Mulholland thanked the Kyogle Lions Club for its ongoing support in maintaining and upgrading the popular route.

She also thanked the State Government for its contribution to the project of \$639,000 through the Fixing Local Roads program and the Federal Government for its \$213,000 through Roads to Recovery.

Key elements of the project included:

- installation of new drainage culverts;
- road widening;
- improvements to the road alignment;
- pavement rehabilitation and stabilisation; and
- the extension of the existing guard rail system.
