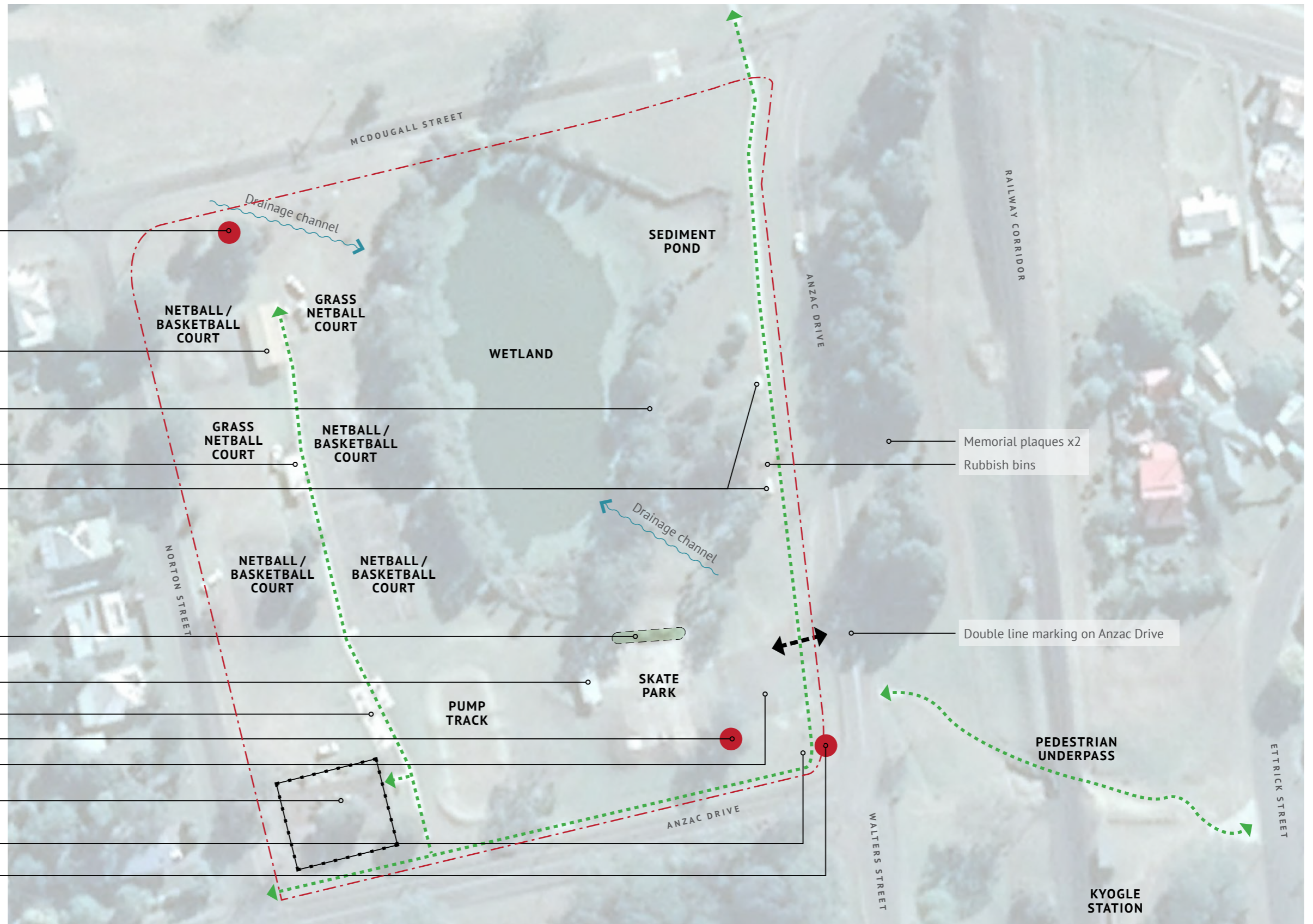

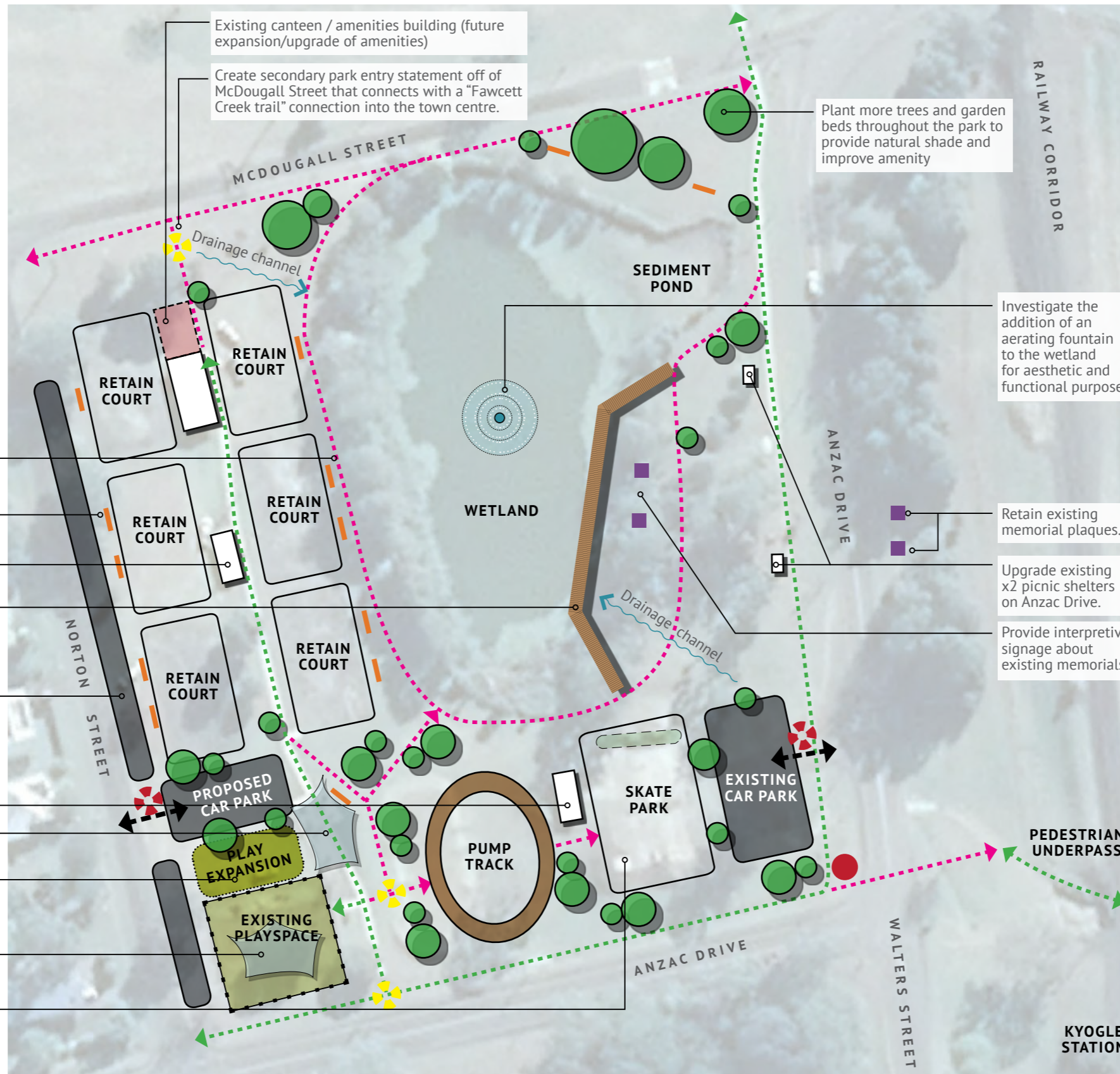

- Retain existing shelter and picnic facilities
- Investigate opportunity to provide a floating boardwalk to provide public interaction with the water (ensure the design caters to varying flood levels)
- Provide nose-in car parking along Norton Street (parking bays to avoid existing trees)
- Retain existing picnic shelter. Install BBQ and bins.
- Provide shade sail over outdoor fitness equipment
- Opportunity to expand playspace to create a regional-level playground attraction.
- Provide a shade sail over existing playground should no upgrade occur.
- Investigate opportunities to continue to improve/upgrade the skate park over time.

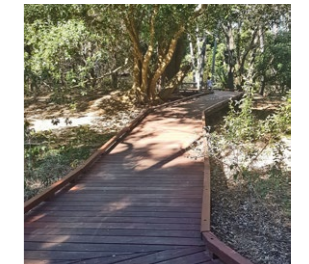
