

## Art Market a joint effort

Arts Kyogle, the Kyogle District Chamber of Commerce (KDCC) and Kyogle Council are collaborating to hold a *Christmas Art Market* from 4 December 2024 to 11 January 2025.

Artworks from Kyogle-based artists will be on display and available for purchase inside the old IGA display window as well as the vacant shop at 131 Summerland Way.

Kyogle Mayor Cr Danielle Mulholland said the ‘art market’ was an exciting new initiative which would bring colour and vibrancy to Kyogle’s CBD throughout the festive season.

“It also gives people the chance to buy some wonderful art and provides a means for our incredibly talented local artists to sell some of their work,” she said.

“It’s a win win for all involved.”

Organised and hosted by Arts Kyogle, the art market will also provide an opportunity for the community to connect with the art group formerly known as the Kyogle and District Arts Council.

“This is a great collaboration which will showcase our artists and their work and raise awareness in the community of Arts Kyogle, the work they are doing what they hope to achieve,” Cr Janet Wilson said.

The artworks can be viewed any time through the IGA window, with people able to buy artworks on display by attending the vacant shop. The shop will open on Wednesday to Saturday from 10 am – 2pm, with the possibility of remaining open for late night shopping depending on the level of interest.
