How can I apply?

When do applications open?

April 1, 2026

When do applications close?

May 3, 2026

When will I find out if I'm successful? – Timeframes

Successful applications will be finalised at the July 13th Council meeting. Successful applicants will be contacted the following week.

When does my event need to take place?

Your event needs to take place between July 2026 and June 2027.

What events will be funded?

Your event must be held within the Kyogle LGA, with the purpose to enhance the community, liveability and prosperity of Kyogle LGA, the towns and villages.

What events are not eligible for funding?

An event:

- Not held in the Kyogle LGA.
- That has already been held or will have already been held by the time grants are awarded.
- Submitted by State or Federal Government organisations.
- For the sole purpose of fundraising for a charity, not-for-profit organisation or individual.
- Which is regarded as a private function or exclusively for members of a community organisation.
- That may be perceived as primarily political in nature or divisive within the community.

- That promotes the consumption of alcohol, drugs, tobacco and tobacco substitutes, or gambling.
- That has already received financial support from Council.

Can I apply for multi-year funding?

Yes. Applicants who host an ongoing annual event can apply for up to 3 years of funding. If you apply for multi-year funding, you are required to provide additional information. The application form has a question that outlines the additional information required.

Please note: there is no requirement to apply for multi-year funding, and most applications will be for 1 year funding (July 2026 – June 2027).

How will my application be assessed?

Applications will be assessed against the following criteria:

- The economic, social and cultural benefit.
- Alignment with Council priorities as outlined in the Kyogle Community Strategic Plan 2025-2035 CSP.
- Inclusiveness and accessibility.
- Safety and compliance.
- Capacity to deliver.
- Value for money.
